Section 1: Student Information

- Please use only one admission form for all students of the same immediate family.
- Write legibly and carefully. Fill out all fields of this application. Write (NA) if not-applicable.
- Provide most recent information and attach all required documents
- Parents are responsible to provide accurate information. The school reserves the right to deny or revoke admission to students if records show that false or misleading information has been provided on the application form.
- Once you signed and submitted this form, you will be notified if your child(ren) has (have) been accepted at the Islamic School of Portland. Submitting this application does not guarantee admission at the school.
- Extra requirements:
 - provide copies of updated health records (immunizations, new medical conditions, etc)
 - **[for new applicants only]** provide copies of student's birth certificate and academic record for the previous year
 - **[for new applicants only]** pass ISP Arabic and English entrance exams for students of 2nd grade and up. This includes a personal essay for students in grades 4 and up. Contact ISP office for more information.
- All students should meet the age requirement as summarized below: (**no exceptions** will be given to the age policy)

Grade	Age/Enrollment Requirement
Pre-K	For children who will be at least 4 years by December 31 st of the current school year
KG	For children who will be at least 5 years old by December 31 st of the current school year
1 st	For children who will be at least 6 years old by December 31 st of the current school year
2 nd -8 th **	For children who have successfully completed the 1 st grade -7 th grade

** grades will open on sufficient demand (at least 4 students per class)

- **When your child(ren) is(are) admitted at the Islamic School of Portland, you are committed to abide by all conditions in this form as well as all school policies as outlined in the parents' handbook**

Section 2: Tuition Fees and Financial Agreement

- ISP tuition fees are based on annual enrollment. However, and for your convenience, annual fees have been divided into 9 equal monthly payments.
- Monthly payments start in September and end in May. Monthly payments are due in full by the 5th of every month.
- For overdue accounts, a reminder will be issued by the 6th of the month. A warning with an expulsion notice will be issued by the end of the month. After the warning, student(s) will not be accepted back in class until balance is paid in full. Missed class time and material will not be compensated.
- Parents who can not make payments for a given month due to some circumstances should request an extension or a payment plan **in writing**, explaining the reason for the delay, and get an answer **in writing** from the office before the payment due date. The school may accept or deny the request.
- Payments are not prorated based on the number of school days in a month. You are committed to the same payment every month even if a month includes vacation time.
- Tuition fees should be paid regardless of absence periods due to sickness, travel, etc. Adjustment will be only made in cases of late enrollment due to transfer.
- In case of a justified withdrawal from the school (for example, moving out to another state), parents/legal guardians are responsible for full fees including the last month attended.
- Any **outstanding balance** from last year **must be paid** before the start of new school year. **Failure to pay outstanding balance in full will result in denial of admission.**
- Returned/bounced check(s) due to "insufficient funds", "stopped payment", or "closed account" for any reason will incur a school handling charge of \$7 per check.
- Money paid is for tuition only. Transportation of children to and from school will be the parents' responsibility. In addition, parents/legal guardians are responsible for text-books payments, student schools supplies, and standardized test fees (for example: Oregon State Assessment Test).
- **For families requesting financial aid:**, please fill and return a "Financial Assistance Form" in addition to this form and attach it to this form. Financial aid is limited.
